#### Senior Caucus Political Affairs Committee

The DFL Senior Caucus Political Affairs Committee (PAC) identifies, researches, and develops priorities for legislative action benefiting seniors throughout the state based on input from members, interviews with legislators and coordination with other entities working towards shared goals for improved services for seniors. In addition to past priorities, the PAC has three new legislative priorities for the 2023 session:

- Addressing Minnesota's severe workforce shortage through increased wages for in-home care and nursing home staff. The lack of caregivers threatens seniors' ability to stay in their own homes and is negatively impacting quality of care for nursing home and assisted living residents.
- Hoffman, Abeler, Kupec, Hauschild, Farnsworth) SF780 (Edelson with 14 others) SF0733 (Nursing Facility Payment RatesHoffman, Abeler, Fateh, Dzeidzic, Miller) SF7 (Noor with 11 others) HF32 (Caregiver Stabilization Act)
- Establishing a Legislative Task Force on Aging to review the needs of Minnesota's seniors. It is hoped that this legislation could lead to a Department on Aging to advocate for and coordinate senior services across agencies.
   HF0979 (Kleven, Noor and 20 others)SF1022 (Morrison, Wiklund, Hoffman, Abeler, Marty)
- Increasing funds for the senior nutrition program. State funds for programs like home delivered meals and food bank assistance have not been significantly increased for over two decades\ despite increased food costs and need for food support. HF2523

#### TECHNICAL TIP OF THE MONTH

There's one simple thing you can do that significantly reduces your risk of getting hacked on the Internet: use a unique password per account. The reason is simple. A single website that gets hacked can expose your password at that one site, but not at any other sites. However, a password that is used at multiple sites can expose you to a lot more cases of hacked accounts. Also, beware of the "secret" information that some sites collect to help you reset your password. It can also be used to hack your accounts if it's the same at multiple sites. Make your passwords out of silly phrases—the more they are the easier it is to use them. Here's an example: WoodyfuzzSoap3
