POSTCARD WRITING!! Get Out the Vote (GOTV)

GOTV is one of our strongest contributions to the election of Democrats statewide. It requires work from every Chapter, and we see results!

Twenty thousand or more preprinted postcards will be distributed among the Chapters to mail to targeted voters. **Numbers are key** – we must send as many cards as possible to keep Minnesota BLUE!

Targeting methods will be determined by each Chapter with assistance from the state DFL Senior Caucus. Postage will be paid by the state Caucus. The addresses will be handwritten by Chapter members, along with the names of Democratic candidates for US Congressional Districts, and MN House Districts. A handwritten message is far more effective at getting people to pay attention and, ultimately, to vote. The card will then serve as a guide for the voter to take to the polls and fill in their ballot.



SCAMS AND FRAUDS! Protect your digital self.

"Phishing" is a serious threat where scammers pose as trusted people and organizations to steal your sensitive information.

To keep your information and accounts safe; recognize common phishing tactics:

- Unexpected Requests: A call from a familiar number asking for your password due to 'suspicious activity.'
- Urgent Appeals: Emails
 claiming problems with your
 bank account that require
 immediate attention to avoid
 fees.

Defend Yourself

Protect yourself and your money with these safety measures.

- Use Unique Passwords: Use and regularly update unique passwords for different accounts.
- Enhance Security: Install and update security software on all of your digital devices. Enable multi-factor authentication for all of your accounts.
- Verify Sources: Always
 confirm requests for your
 sensitive information using
 official channels. Do not
 automatically use the contact

- Too-Good-to-be-True Offers:
 Texts offering free items in exchange for personal details like your social security number.
- Malicious Links: Unexpected payment links that secretly install malware on your device.
- Impersonation/Spoofing:
 Callers pretending to be IT professionals needing your one-time passcode to resolve an issue.

- information in messages sent to you.
- Careful Clicking: Avoid clicking suspicious links or downloading unknown attachments.
- Stay Vigilant: Be skeptical of calls and messages that demand immediate action or personal information.

Your personal and financial information is for your eyes only. Do not respond to **unsolicited** calls, texts, emails or other messages that feel out of place.


