ISSUES TO WRITE TO LEGISLATORS ABOUT

Federal:

- Tell congress to extend Medicare reimbursement for telehealth
- Effect of cuts Older Americans Act, Medicaid expansion, DEI and LGBTQ protections
- Possible elimination of Dept of Education, USAID, WHO membership

Minnesota:

- Disappearance of rural hospitals, rural health care
- Age-Friendly provision not in current budget proposal
- Legacy bill, giving priority to seniors for services
- Housing bill, providing support services for seniors staying in homes

LEGISLATORS TO CONTACT:

Call, email, and write postal letters. Doesn't matter if they are democrats or republicans. If you are unhappy about what is going on, they represent you.

If all 1000 Senior Caucus members write them once or twice a week or a month, they will get the message. This is why we are a state wide team – to make a difference!!
